We're continuing to make people our priority while focusing on the mission and vision God has called us to. For all those who attend Crossroads and for those who are yet to come through our doors, let our witness be of love, grace and unity. Please adhere to the following for the benefit of all in attendance and to maintain a positive witness to our community.

**Doors Open:** All exterior and interior doors will be propped open to minimize contact. Our first impressions team will greet you and give further instructions as you arrive.

**Face Masks:** Face masks are to be worn while inside the building, unless you are seated socially distanced from other family groups.

**Physical Distancing:** Maintaining physical distancing of six feet between individuals or family groups enables us to provide an environment where more people feel comfortable and healthy practices are followed. Our auditoriums will be configured to allow for individuals or family groups to practice responsible social distancing.

We'll be working to minimize contact in our common spaces by placing service elements on your chair. There will be a place for you to give your tithe and offering as you leave the service, but we also encourage you to take advantage of our safe and secure online giving.

**Kidzlink & Crave:** Our campuses are providing opportunities for kids and youth to participate in Kidzlink & Crave services. Find specific times for your campus by visiting the Location menu at the top of our website. If you plan to bring your child to a Kidzlink service, you can expect to see their room's setup to help us practice social distancing. Where that is not possible, we do require everyone over the age of 2 to wear a face covering while in the building. There are exceptions for medical reasons.

**Cafe:** You're welcome to bring your own coffee/beverage, but we will not be serving any drinks or food from our café.

**Cleaning:** We have been and will continue to do additional cleaning and sanitizing of surfaces and areas that are visited frequently at our campuses. Access to parts of the building not in use will be limited.
