



Ministerial Skills Course

Preparing for Spiritualist Ministry

Ministerial Skills brings you knowledge of ministerial responsibilities in 96 hours of class work. Classes take place on Zoom for one week, followed later by a week of classroom instruction at MPI. Classes are held with specific church assignments requiring student attendance at either an on-line or in-person Spiritualist religious service. Included are lectures, hands-on ministerial experiences through role-playing of life-like situations such as weddings, funerals, and other special services. Studies include counseling on pre-marital, marriage, suicide, family dynamics, violence, chemical dependency, death and dying, and the grief process. The class is open to any dedicated student. Ministerial Skills is a required course for those seeking Licentiate Minister or Ordained Minister certification by most Spiritualist organizations.

Early registration is necessary. Needed books must be purchased before the course commences. Contact MPI for detailed logistical information (*location, lodging, meals, transportation*).
