

Demographic Profile

The population in Tooele County, Utah was 63,357 per American Community Survey data for 2013-2017.

The region has a civilian labor force of 30,385 with a participation rate of 68.7%. Of individuals 25 to 64 in Tooele County, Utah, 23.5% have a bachelor's degree or higher which compares with 32.3% in the nation.

The median household income in Tooele County, Utah is \$66,542 and the median house value is \$196,300.
