Jared Snyder is Deputy Commissioner for Air Resources, Climate Change & Energy at the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. In that capacity, he oversees New York's development and implementation of clean air programs and programs to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, including the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative, and he represents the Department in statewide energy planning efforts.

Jared is the Chair of the Ozone Transport Commission and has served as Co-chair of the International Carbon Action Partnership. He is also Secretary, RGGI, Inc. Board of Directors.

Prior to joining DEC Jared Snyder managed air and climate litigation in the New York attorney general's office. Previously he worked for the U.S. Department of Justice handling environmental enforcement
