



Dear Parents/Guardians:

The situation with the Coronavirus is rapidly evolving. As educators, we are responsible for the health and safety of our students, staff, and faculty. According to health experts and the CDC, current risk to our community is presently low. It is, however, prudent that we establish multiple interventions to prevent disease transmission for our school community. We are continuing to follow CDC regulations and directions that have been given to us publicly and those that have been sent internally to our school administration.

On our Cabrini Campus, we are taking the following precautions to better protect our students and staff from the potential spreading of infectious disease:

- Classrooms
  - Every school day, staff will be wiping down their classroom desks with antibacterial wipes in the beginning, middle and end of the day.
  - Staff will wipe down other classroom areas such as light switches, doorknobs and classroom supplies.
- Bathrooms
  - Bathrooms will be cleaned twice during the day and given special attention to disinfecting all commonly touched surfaces.
- Cafeteria
  - The kitchen staff have been given proper cleaning products to clean surfaces between meals. Our cleaning staff also does a thorough cleaning at the end of the day.
- Attendance
  - This is a reminder that if your child is out of school for more than 2 days, a note from the doctor is required. This will be marked as an excused absence.

As we view the current situation regarding the spread of the virus, it is essential to plan for the continuation of student learning. In the event we are directed to close, we are preparing our staff for at home learning to occur.

We continue to be vigilant in our classrooms to protect our school community. We are taking prudent measures to help lessen the possible spread of germs.
