

Workshop Descriptions-2021

<i>Workshops</i>	
Leadership - Advocacy	Find the importance of advocacy skills through interactive and engaging workshops to showcase why advocacy for theatre is crucial to development of theatre education and theatre for audiences around the world. Students will listen to the lessons that the STO's have prepared about advocacy and have a meaningful discussion about why advocating for theatre is important.
Leadership - Respectful communication	Find the importance of communicating respectfully within individual group settings to enhance their roles as leaders. Students will be able to identify the link between respect and communication and what role it plays in conversation. Identify situations where respect and disrespect comes into play.
Leadership - Club Activities	Learn the importance of working together with people of all different skill levels and abilities to create scenes that are amusing and that flow. Students will learn some improvisation games to improve their quick thinking skills and they will be encouraged to help other students that are struggling to make everyone feel included and make them feel successful.
Bonding - Troupe trust	Learn the importance and take the first steps of gaining a deeper sense of trust among your troupe. Students will have deep conversations and participate in meaningful activities to allow the relationships among their troupe members to strengthen.
Bonding - Who Are you	Learn the importance of embracing who you are as an individual, and what strengths and weaknesses you bring to your theatre troupe. Students will engage in discussions and several workshops to get a better sense of who they are and what kind of leader they are in their theatre department.
Bonding - Beginning the bond	Learn the process of developing a bond with other theatre students by engaging in get to know you games and deeper discussions to improve interpersonal skills, as well as bonding skills. Students will meet with other students and form a bond with them, and will be able to form bonds with others more easily through this workshop.
