FEE SCHEDULE

Students \$60.00/person (T-shirts are included in the price of camp. Please make sure you add that when you register your kiddos in the registration portal. If you don't add it to the registration, we assume you don't want to order them.)

Troupe Directors and Chaperones \$20.00/person

State Thespian Officers \$30.00/person

School Registration Fee (required) \$30.00. This fee will be added. If you submit for payment before it is added, another invoice will be sent.

Schools are limited to 12 students attending Camp.

REGISTRATION

Part 1- Register your school

1. Click on CAMP on the main menu. At the bottom of the page, click on LEADERSHIP CAMP REGISTRATION.
2. You will need to fill in certain information for example, how many students you are bringing based on gender.
3. Once you have entered all that information, you will click on SUBMIT at which point you will be directed to the Arizona Thespians Registration Portal. This is the same account you use for the AZ Thespian Festival in November.

4. You can add new students if you need to or register students who have been to Thespian Festival. Click on DIRECTORY then click on ADD STUDENTS. The list of your students who have been to a Thespian event before will pop up. If you click on the EDIT button next to their name you can register them and order t-shirts. (Please note this is the only way to order camp shirts and all campers get a shirt included in the cost unless you don't fill it out we are assuming you don't want to order shirts.)

5. To sign up for workshops: click on REGISTER, from the drop down menu, select WORKSHOPS. From the menu options please sign up your students for your workshops you want them to attend. A maximum of four students from a troupe can be in a workshop (for instance, if you bring 7 students four students can attend true colors in session 1 but the other three would have to attend another workshop(s)). After you select the workshop, you will assign your students by clicking the + next to their name under the "ADD ALL" box.

If there are more than four students in a workshop they will be re-assigned.

Make sure the workshops are on the day you are planning on attending. The menu gives you the title, session and the date to help you select.

6. Please add the school fee to your invoice. If you do not, and submit, you will receive another invoice for this part. Click on REGISTER, from the drop down menu select SERVICES and click on the "X" next to school fee.

Part 2 – Consent forms

1. Make sure to bring up consent forms for your students and all adults who are attending. There should be 2 copies, one for registration to keep and one for the sponsor to keep.

2. Click on CAMP on the main menu. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on CONSENT FORM. Download and print off to have students AND adults fill out.

3. Please note, any special school policy permission forms for travel are your responsibility.

Part 3 – State Thespian Officer (STO) Application process – ALL APPLICATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS ARE DUE July 1,2021.

We are trying something different this year. Troupe Directors do not need to serve on the State Board if they have a student who wants to be a State Thespian Officer. HOWEVER, these students must still attend camp with their troupes and sponsors in order to be eligible for consideration.

Please stress to your students who want to run for an STO position, that it is a time commitment just like a job, not just monthly meetings but there is work between as well. It takes a lot of time to plan all our events for the year.

Have your student who wants to run for an STO position fill out the online form before their arrival to camp. They will need to upload a photo to their application. The photo should not have special filters or be unprofessional looking.

1. Click on CAMP from the main menu.

2. Scroll to the bottom and click on the STO APPLICATION link.

3. Please fill out and click SUBMIT when complete.

SPONSORS, in order for your student to run for a STO position you have to You will also need to fill out the recommendation form. Please make sure the student has had their parents fill out their part of the application process as well.

1. The link for the STO RECOMMENDATION form is located on the bottom of the CAMP page on the website.

2. Please fill out a separate form for each STO applicant.

Please call 511 or go to www.az511.gov to get updated information about road conditions along all routes that you may take.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE TIMES: Please plan your arrival for between 9-9:30am on your selected day. Driving times, of course, are extremely variable; but you can usually figure on about one hour from Payson.

CELL PHONES: PLEASE discourage your students from using their cell phones for social reasons in workshops and presentations. It is understandable in this day and age that they are used as a tool.

Please be sure every parent has the phone number of the camp for emergencies – (927) 535-4131. So let’s try to hang up the phones and enjoy the beautiful peaceful surroundings – undisturbed.

TEACHER WORKSHOPS: There is a teacher track at camp so you can earn professional development hours.

SUPPLIES/EQUIPMENT for the AZ Thespians Leadership Camp

- ø Water bottle (the water up there is amazing). Remind your students to hydrate.
- ø Light jacket (it could rain and become chilly)
- ø Closed shoes are highly recommended as some activities are planned for the dirt & grassy areas.
- ø Rain gear or umbrella (it is the monsoon season after all!)
- ø **A Watch (a MUST!! Everything runs by the clock.)**
- ø Camera (optional, but most everyone likes to bring back some memories and souvenirs.)
- ø Pen and/or pencil (Yes, you’ll be taking notes.)
- ø Insect repellent
- ø Hat and sunglasses (the sun at that elevation is VERY intense.)

- ø Sunscreen – again the sun is very intense at the high elevation
- ø Positive attitudes

SPONSORS ONLY:

- ø Make sure you have 2 copies of your consent forms. We need to keep a copy on hand, as do you.
- ø Bring a comfy camp chair. Please don't let students bring them.
- ø STO applications are due July 1th.
