London (February 26, 2020) – Since 2013, thanks to an official declaration by the United Nations General Assembly, March 3 has been noted as “**World Wildlife Day.**” This year’s theme is “Sustaining All Life on Earth,” with the intent for the world’s human residents to celebrate plants and animals around the globe while focusing on conservation of life both on land and below water. The ultimate goal is halting biodiversity loss.

Although that’s an ambitious goal, one way for the public to start fulfilling it is to see some of the world’s most fascinating animal species in their natural habitats and contribute to conservation efforts through travel. So, if World Wildlife Day inspires you to explore the natural world around you, here’s a sampling of some of On The Go Tours’ **most popular wildlife-related tours**. *Please note that starting prices do not include international airfare but do include all internal flights once on tour.*

- [Shere Khan](#) (10 days) – The trip’s name, Shere Khan, translates to “Tiger King.” It’s the name of the tiger who’s the antagonist in author Rudyard Kipling’s famed *Jungle Book*. Participants learn all about the elusive **Bengal tiger** during their visit to Ranthambore National Park in India, where they’ll embark on three different drives so they can try to spot this magnificent endangered species. Other highlights of this trip include a full tour of Delhi, a stroll through the preserved city of Fatehpur Sikri, visits to the Taj Mahal and Agra Fort, and a stay at the Maharaja’s Palace Bhanwar Vilas. On The Go Tours is a proud participant in the [Travel Operators for Tigers program](#), sharing the philosophy that the best way to save the tigers’ natural habitat is through well-managed tourism into India’s wilderness and tiger reserves. On The Go Tours donates \$30 USD for every traveler who visits a tiger reserve through their tours. *This tour runs with a minimum of two and maximum of 24 participants. Pricing starts at \$1,236 USD per person.*

- [Gorilla and Game Trek](#) (15 days) – This two-week trip takes travelers on a trek through the dense jungle as they search for Uganda’s endangered **mountain gorillas**. Gorillas aren’t the only animals featured on this tour, however; it also includes time at Masai Mara, one of Kenya’s finest wildlife reserves and a great place to spot several iconic African species. Participants also visit Lake Naivasha, home to the rare African fish eagle, and Lake Bunyoni, noted for its incredible diversity of bird life. For those seeking one of those “bucket-list” moments, the tour also features an Equator crossing, giving participants a chance to put one foot in each of the world’s hemispheres. This tour is a proper overland safari, with participants bringing their own sleeping bags, buying and cooking food from markets, and sharing drinks with villagers at local bars. *This tour runs with a minimum of four participants and a maximum of 30. Pricing starts at \$798 USD per person, not including a Gorilla Permit (which On The Go Tours arranges on guests’ behalf) and a local guide payment (which ensures guests’ money goes directly to the people hosting them).*
- [Wildlife Express](#) (22 days) – If you’ve ever dreamed of exploring Africa on an official safari and seeing all the wildlife by day – **elephants, lions, giraffes and zebras** – and then camping with a ceiling of stars above you at night, this is the tour for you. The trip takes guests to Kenya, Zanzibar, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Tanzania, Malawi and Botswana, with plenty of time in national parks along the way. Highlights include Victoria Falls, the Serengeti, the Ngorongoro Crater, Mt. Kilimanjaro and a cruise along the Chobe River. This, too, is an overland safari that includes a bit of “roughing it” as you truly immerse yourself in the continent’s natural elements. *This tour runs with a minimum of four participants and a maximum of 30. Pricing starts at \$948 USD per person, not including a local guide payment (which ensures guests’ money goes directly to the people hosting them).*

For those travelers who want a once-in-a-lifetime adventure that requires a little more time, On The Go Tours also offers the [Big 5 Safari](#), an incredible 36-day trip that combines elements of both the Gorilla and Game Trek and Wildlife Express tours and starts at just \$1,548 USD. At the other end of the spectrum, for those who have more budget than time, the [Ultimate Galapagos](#) highlights an eight-day, first-class cruise around the islands that inspired Charles Darwin, allowing guests to encounter **sea lions, giant tortoises, iguanas** and an array of **colorful birds**. This trip starts at \$9,295 USD per person and welcomes a minimum of four and a maximum of 16 participants, ensuring some truly customized, once-in-a-lifetime experiences.
