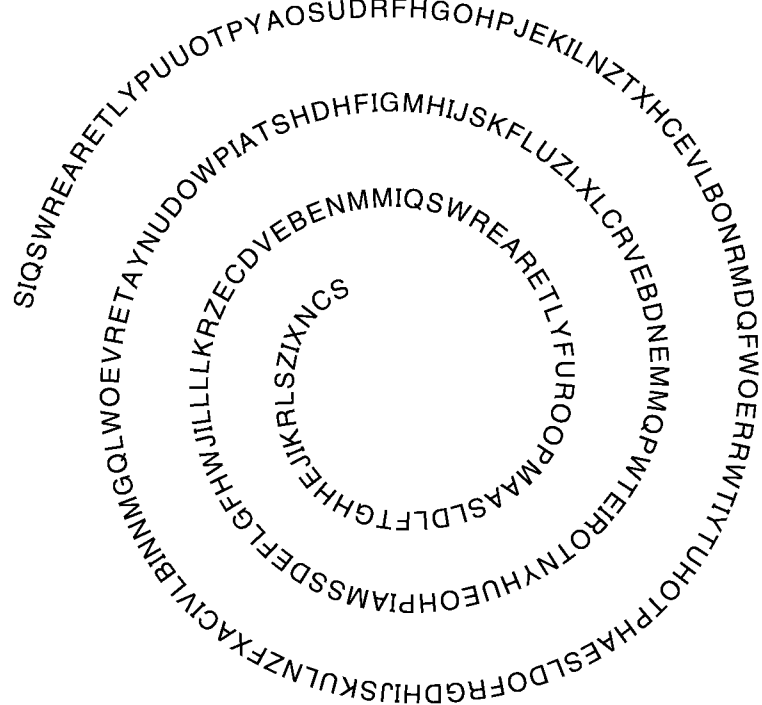

Find the 12 differences in the second picture.

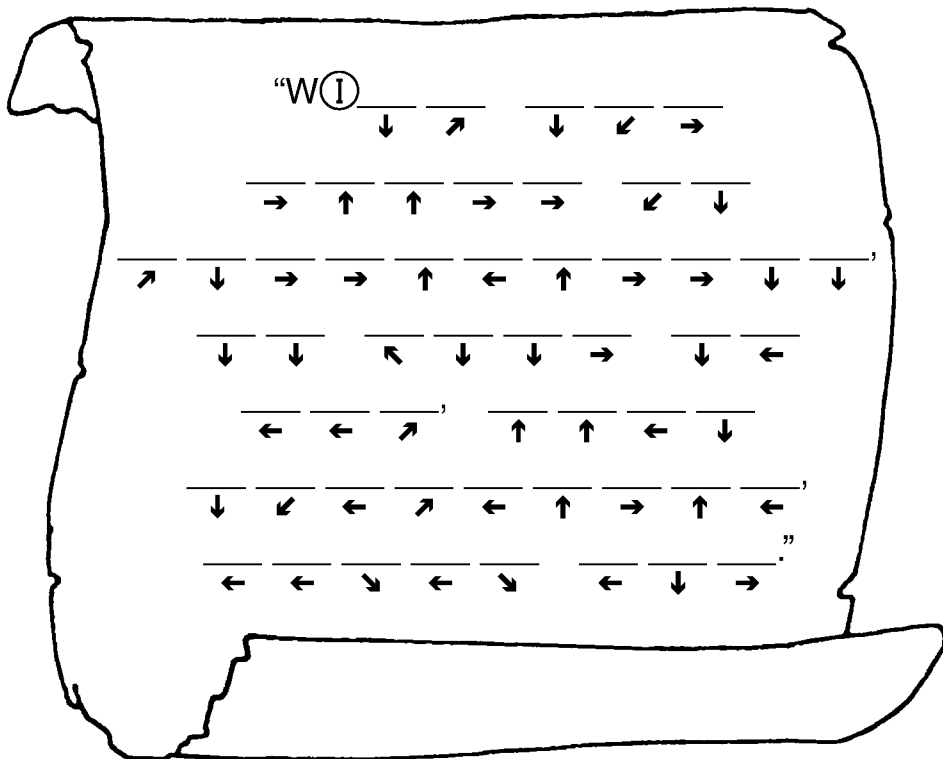


The psalmist said that God does not keep a record of our sins. What do we have from God instead?

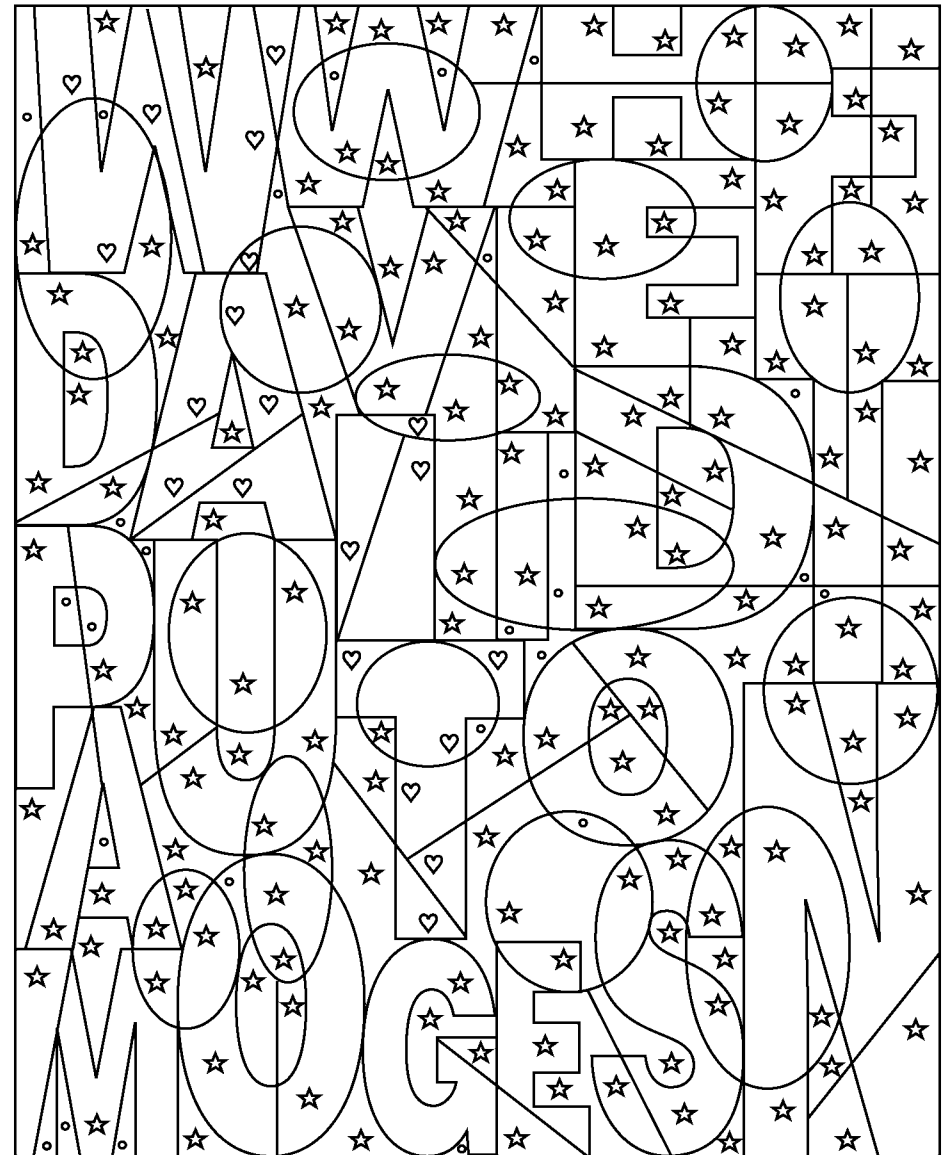
