

Rowland Heights Buckboard Parade EVENT NOTICE for October 19, 2019



**The annual Rowland Heights Buckboard Days Parade will be held
Saturday, October 19, 2019 - access to your home or business may be impacted**

The following road/intersection closures will be in effect from 7:00am to 11:15am
Nogales Avenue from Pathfinder Road to Colima Road,
Colima Road from Nogales Avenue to Nausika Avenue
Banida Avenue from Colima Road to Rowland Park
Colima Road and Otterbein intersection

Los Angeles County and the Buckboard Days Parade Committee are taking several measures to minimize the impacts. Mailed notifications will go out the week prior to the parade to notify those residences and businesses that will be impacted by street closures.

TRAFFIC CONTROL AND STREET CLOSURES: Temporary closure signs will be posted on the affected streets prior to and on the day of the event.

SHUTTLES: There will be limited van shuttles for Parade goers running between Rowland Heights Park and the parking lot at Killian School, on Parade day from 7-8:45am. The Heights Hopper will resume ridership shortly after the parade leaving Rowland Heights Park. The Hopper leaves the park and runs in close proximity to Killian School for drop-offs.

PARKING:

The Rite Aid Parking lot will be accessible from Nogales Avenue north of Colima Road, and from Colima Road west of Nogales

The 99 Cent Only store shopping center can be accessed by making a left turn from Nogales north of Colima
The Killian School Parking lot

The Big Lots Parking lot will be accessible until 7:00a.m and after the parade ends (approximately 11:30AM)

PUBLIC SAFETY: Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department personnel will be on site to quickly respond to any emergency or public safety issue.

EXITING NEIGHBORHOODS NEAR THE ROWLAND HEIGHTS PARK: In case of a verified emergency, law enforcement will allow passage. Waterfall Estates gates will be closed. If you live north of Colima, exit via Otterbein. Law enforcement will set up at Colima at Otterbein to allow passage across Colima every 15 minutes until the parade starts at 9am. Volunteers will have signs with directions to Rowland Park via Otterbein and Colima. Colima will reopen after the parade.

STREET CLOSURE NOTICE AND “NO PARKING” AREAS

The 47th Annual Buckboard Days Parade and Festival will be held on Saturday, **October 19, 2019**. The parade will begin at 9:00 a.m.

The parade will last approximately 2-½ hours, and several streets will be closed to traffic. **There will also be streets that will be marked “No Parking” the night before.**

PARADE ROUTE: The parade will assemble on Nogales St. and travel north to Colima Road, then make a right turn and proceed east to Banida Ave. and turn left, ending at Rowland Heights County Park.

Following the parade there will be a Family Festival at the park. You are invited!
