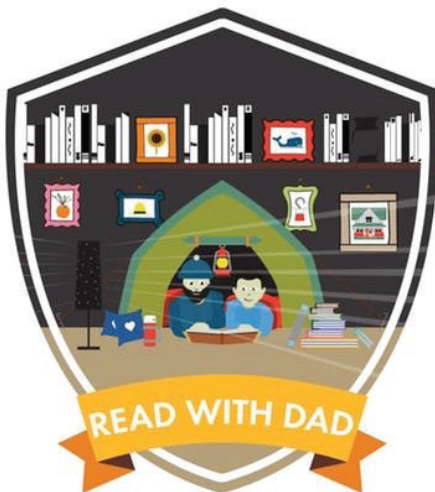


Community Event

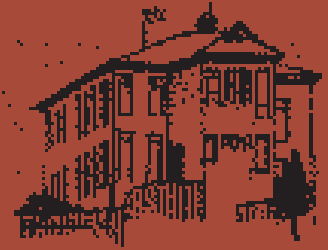
