



Hi Vizcaya,

As you know Orange County has issued a stay at home order for all Orange County residents effective 11PM Thursday March 26. Additional details of this order can be found at [Orange County Stay At Home Order](#).

In response to this order, Vizcaya Master HOA has restricted access to the Clubhouse and swimming pool. Walden Security will continue to manage access control; P&R Management will continue to monitor the property; trash and garbage collection services will continue.

- The owner entrance gate at the main gate was hit and damaged by an owner last week. It will take at least a week to repair; it may take longer to enter the community, so we ask for your patience and understanding. Please use Gatekey.
- More people are walking through the neighborhood. Take time to meet your neighbors and say hello but keep your social distance. With so many people walking it means that to maintain 6 feet from each other, some neighbors will be walking on the side of the road. **Please drive the speed limit** (15 MPH in most areas) and **watch for walkers!**
- Orange County has asked all residents to remain at home, and if you go out, remain 6 feet from other individuals. You are asked not to visit your relatives.
- Currently, the tennis court remains open, but we are continuing to evaluate. Please keep your distance. Help other users by wiping the gate with a sanitizing wipe.
- To those owners walking dogs, please remember some neighbors and their children are afraid of dogs so please keep your pets on a leash and control their activities. Please, clean up after your dogs.
- Take time to say "Thank You" to the gate guards, P&R management company staff, our vendors, the mail person, Amazon/UPS/FEDEX drivers and others who continue to support our community during this crisis.
