

DIGNITARY PROTECTION ASSIGNMENTS

On occasion, the Sheriff's Office is called upon to protect events that include special dignitaries. Various groups within the sheriff's office work together to develop tactical strategies. Tactical dispatchers, Detention's Special Response team, Patrol's SWAT team, and volunteers from the Sheriff's auxiliary teams are all called upon to provide assistance.

MEDIA

The Media Division performs public contact work providing information to the public and news media acting as the representative for the Sheriff's Office. Their general duties include: participating in the development and creation of community programs; presenting program to community groups; preparing and updating news releases; reviewing reports for public information; compiling statistics and other information along with maintaining records and files of program activities.

INCIDENT COMMAND TEAM (ICT)

The Incident Command Team (ICT) is the agency's internal team that manages significant and complex incidents within our jurisdiction, both pre-planned and unplanned. ICT is deployed for natural disasters, major crimes, missing persons and Search and Rescue cases. ICT operates under the Incident Command System principles and is staffed with paid employees and trained volunteers.
