

## BELMONT HIGH SCHOOL ANP PARENT/STUDENT CONTRACT

This contract states the rules that must be followed at the 2020 Senior All Night Graduation Party (ANP). By signing your name to the contract, you acknowledge the following rules and will abide by them, and understand that, if you violate the rules, you will be subject to the consequences as listed below. Both student and parent must sign this contract in order to buy a ticket and attend the ANP.

### Rules and Consequences:

- Students must arrive between 9:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on June 7, 2020 for the ANP. No one will be admitted after 10:00 p.m.
  - **CONSEQUENCE: Student will be denied admission.**
- Students must remain within the physical boundaries of the ANP area. A student may not leave the ANP before 5:00 a.m. on June 8 unless (i) approval is obtained from an authorized ANP chaperone after contacting the student's parent; or (ii) a parent of the student has notified ANP organizers in advance of the party.
  - **CONSEQUENCE: If student is found beyond the specified areas, a parent will be called and the student will be sent home.**
- Inappropriate gestures, language, or behaviors will not be accepted.
  - **CONSEQUENCE: A parent will be called and the student will be sent home.**
- The ANP is smoke free. This includes all areas of the ANP.
  - **CONSEQUENCE: School rules will apply.**
- Students must adhere to all school rules. No bags are allowed. Any pocketbooks/belongings will be searched. In addition no beverages or containers may be brought into the ANP. Medications can be checked in with the health/safety staff on duty. Do not bring valuable items, as the ANP organizers are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
  - **CONSEQUENCE: School rules will apply.**
- Students will attend the ANP alcohol and drug free. An ANP representative, health/safety ANP staff member or law enforcement official will evaluate students if deemed warranted. The school and ANP staff reserve the right to utilize any appropriate methodology to determine if a student is alcohol or drug impaired. It shall be a violation of the alcohol and drug policy for any student to display evidence of:
  - a. Using or having used alcohol and/or drugs.
  - b. Possessing alcohol and/or drugs.
  - c. Being knowingly in the presence of alcohol and/or drugs.
  - d. Transferring or transporting alcohol and/or drugs.
  - e. Knowingly or willfully assisting another person in using alcohol and/or drugs.
  - **CONSEQUENCE: Parents will be notified immediately and students will be sent home. If a parent is not available, the student will be placed in the custody of the local police department.**
