City of Waveland announces closures

- The following facilities will be closed until further notice:
  - Ground Zero Museum, Coleman Ave.
  - MLK Community Center, Herlihy St.
  - Wilcox Park on Waveland Ave
  - Gex Park on Coleman Ave.
  - Elwood Bourgeois Park on Central Ave.
  - Court will also be postponed until April 21 or 23, 2020

**Facilities:**

- *ALL* public restrooms maintained by the City of Waveland will close immediately due to recommendations from the Mississippi Department of Health.
- The City of Waveland is making moves to limit all non-essential personnel from coming to work in the next week to implement safe operating procedures. This process will be evaluated on a week by week basis.
- Due to this limited staff, please use emails and phone calls to handle City business that does not require face to face interaction.
- The City of Waveland would like to remind its residents that these precautions are for the health and safety of **OUR** community. Please check the City of Waveland's website or Facebook page for updates.
