Effective March 17, 2020, due to the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency adopted by the Board of Supervisors on March 16, 2020 concerning the spread of COVID-19, and the recommendation that we avoid groups of more than 10 people, we are LIMITING the number of customers in the office at one time to 2.

Voter Registration - If you need to register to vote or make changes to your voter registration, you may do so by mail or in person. You may also call our office to obtain a form or you can go online and download from the Secretary of State's website.

Marriage Licenses – If you are getting married in the near future, you may come in to obtain your license. However, we do ask that if your wedding is at a future date, that you wait until closer to your wedding date to obtain.

Circuit & County Court – You may file by mail, fax or online through MS. Electronic Court unless it is an appeal or complaint which you will have to come into the office to file. All Circuit Court cases have been postponed until April 6, 2020. All County Court cases have been postponed until April 17, 2020. Please call our office to check on your court date.

Payments on Court Fines – You can mail a money order to our office. Please be sure to include your name and address on the money order and we will mail a receipt back to you.
