Effective *immediately* all City of Waveland buildings including City Hall, the Police Department, Fire Departments, and City Yard will have extremely limited access to the general public. This measure is being taken to ensure the health and safety of the residence and employees of the City of Waveland. City personnel will continue to keep the general public up to date on the latest developments as they come to our attention.

Utility payments can be submitted online or by dropping off the payment in a sealed envelope (please use a wet cloth and not saliva) in the drop off box located on the first floor of City Hall next to the main entrance in the front of the building.

The City understands that the online payment system has a convenience surcharge and is working with its payment system and Utility Department to mitigate this cost the best we can. This may come in the form of a credit posted to your account in the amount of the convenience surcharge.
