DIRECTIONS: Mingo Trails Saddle Club is approx 2 hours south of **Atlanta**: Take I-75
South from Atlanta. In Macon, take I-16 East. Take Exit #32 off of I-16 onto Hwy 112.
Turn Left onto GA-112 North. Go 16 miles. Take a slight Right onto Long Branch Road
and go 2 miles. Turn Right onto Little Sandy Creek Road and continue for about a mile.
Mingo Trails campground entry will be on your right
