NRA Chief Range Safety Officer (14 Hours) – \$300

Instructor Candidates (IC) will demonstrate organizational and teaching skills via participation in practical exercises, and complete a written exam. IC receive NRA Basic RSO lesson plans, student course packet, and PowerPoint.
