(Kindergarten -8 yrs.)

Who needs remote learning help? We have your back at The Barnyard School!

What to expect from us:

- Students will work online in their own dedicated space for completing their work, with their own learning materials, and being live with their teacher.
- Our teachers will be on hand if they need guidance. Please keep in mind that they are not a 1:1 tutor or will they take the place of their public-school teacher. They will be there to help clarify instructions from their teacher, if they are feeling overwhelmed or need guidance with their school day.
- We are not a substitute for instruction and all homework/school work should be reviewed by the parents/guardians.
- When your child goes back to school and begins their synchronous learning, we will have to adjust their schedules. They will be able to come on the day's they do not have live learning however they will be required to bring their work with them as other kids may have live learning. The teacher will plan and provide activities during their public school learning breaks.
- Art, STEM & gross motor activities during breaks
 - We will provide a box with markers, crayons, and colored pencils for each student.
 - For full day students, we will provide extra enrichment opportunities for your child to engage in that they won't get on a computer.
 - Gross motor activates
 - S.T.E.M activates
 - Arts and Crafts
- Weekly/daily check-ins with the teacher if you have questions or concerns. We use an app called Himama that we can correspond with. It's a free to download and once you are enrolled you will get an invite from us.
- Device and Internet issues will sometimes be out of our control. We will make every effort to rectify the problems but sometimes may be out of our control. We are not responsible for lost/stolen items.
- **Staff will be required to wear their mask at all times in the classroom. They will not be required outside if 6 feet can be maintained.**

What your child will need for their day:

- Parents/Guardians are responsible for all materials for their remote learning.
 - For example: Chromebook, laptop, mouse, headphones, any required material from the public school they will need for their learning. Make sure they are fully charged and or send in cords in

- their bags. Children are not allowed to use their devices to play online games unless it is directed from their teacher.
- Send in their class schedules, all username and passwords.
- Half day kids bring a snack (any drinks except sodas).

- Full day kids bring a snack for morning, lunch, afternoon snack (any drinks except sodas).
- Water bottle filled daily.
- Bring a book or quiet activity that they can do if they finish their work prior to others.
- All items must be clearly labeled with child's name on it.
- **Children will be required to wear their mask while entering the classroom but will be allowed to take them off while sitting in their own space. If they need to go to the bathroom or need to walk about the room, they will be required to wear their masks. They are not required to wear their mask outside unless they cannot stay 6 feet apart.**

TUITION/ FEE'S

There are no tuition deductions for absenteeism for any reason; this includes illness, weather conditions, holidays, family vacations etc.

Once your child's weekly schedule has been determined, you will not be allowed to switch days unless there is availability. If you do need to switch days on a permanent basis, it will depend on availability and we will need at least 30 days' notice. If you need to add a temporary day onto your schedule, please make sure you confirm it with the Director for availability and your fee for that day will be paid on that day.

When you plan your family vacation please let our staff know as soon as possible and make sure to either pay for that week in advance or leave a postdated check with your child's teacher the week before you leave for vacation. **\$5.00 a day fee will be added if your payment is not received before you leave.**

- **Tuition Payments will be paid biweekly, due on the 1st and the 15th of the month. Payments must be set up through bill pay from your bank and mailed to the Barnyard. Make sure the payment dates are on the memo line. If your child has a different last name than you, please make sure your child's name is on the memo line too. Tuition will be logged biweekly when received from your bank in the mail.**
- **A \$5 dollar a day, per child late fee will be added each day to your tuition is late.**
- All returned checks are subject to a \$75.00 surcharge.
- ***All families must give a 2 week notice in writing addressed to our Director if you decide to leave our program. When the schools start to go back, we will work with you to adjust your child's schedule but if you choose to leave it will apply.***

Choose:

Half-day 8:00 – 12:00 (\$50) or Full-day 8:00 – 4:00 (\$68)

3 day minimum (must include a M or a F),

5 full days (\$320) also sibling gets 5% off 5 full day only

\$50 deposit/enrollment fee required
