Chaplain's Call - Chaplain Les McClelland

April is always the month when the arrival of showers brings the promise of flowers in May. It is a time when the powers of transition produce enhanced beauty all around us. Grass is growing, lawn mowers are running and the old paint brush is once again being used on the exteriors of homes. This is a month when there is a lot of activity taking place. Winter has retreated into the background and Spring along with its tremendous burst of color once again asserts itself as evidence that the glory of God will not be denied.

This is also true for each of us. It is true that we all experience hills and valleys in the journey of our life. It is also true that far too often we find ourselves complaining about everything that is wrong or could possibly go wrong rather than celebrating all that is right.
