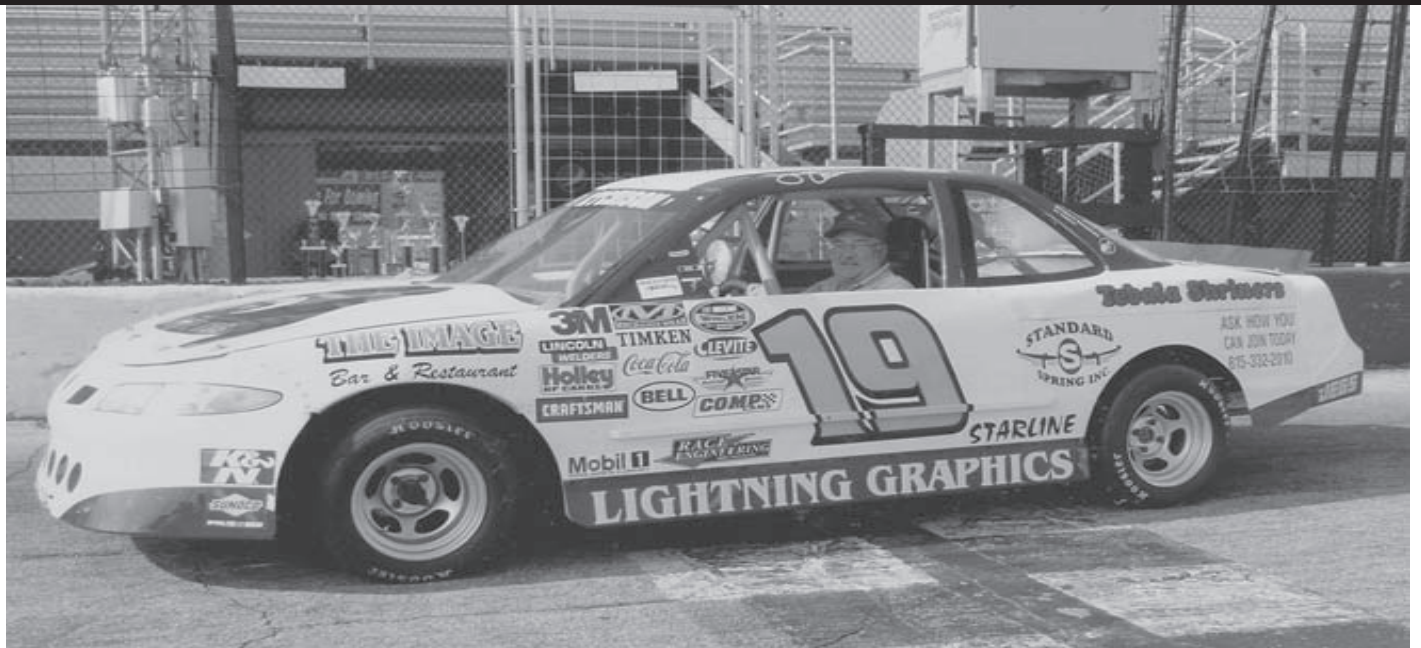

Motion to dispense with minutes by Larry Keyser, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Charles E. Beard, motion carried.

Treasurer Tom Runge P.P. reviewed the fraternity balance sheets which were in balance. P & L wre reviewed. Building Corp financials were reviewed—P & L reviewed. Question & Answer period concerning building costs & expenses. Art Haas questioned net profits for the month—Treasurer explained that the numbers were up due to Onion Sales and Circus income. Motion made by Ken Olafson, P.P. seconded by Charles E. Beard o approve Treasurers Report. Motion carried.

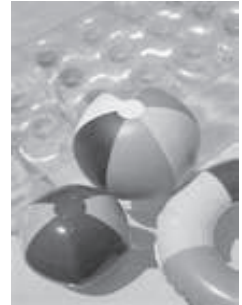
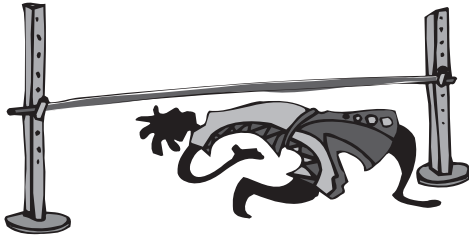
