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### Dependent/youth Rules:

Minor dependents will be extended a complimentary Youth Membership and issued a specifically colored Youth Member Card. The following rules will apply to dependents ages 12 to 17 yrs.: Dependent youth members will not have to be signed in as a Club guest while on Club property.

- A separate, abbreviated youth application is to be completed. (Page 1 & 2)
- Dependent applicants ARE required to complete mandatory Range Safety Orientation (see page 3). “3 Events” attendance is waived for Dependent Youth members.
- RPRC will provide basic Firearm Safety education to Dependent/Youth members when need exists at no cost. Contact the Training Officer to arrange. (see page 3)
- Dependents shall always be accompanied by parent while on RPRC property, & on the same range.
- Grandchildren are eligible ONLY if the grandparents are the documented legal guardian(s) and reside in the same household. Documentation required
- Dependents ages 12 - 17 WILL NOT have individual gate/range access.
- Dependents are not allowed to bring guests under the RPRC Guest Policy.
- Dependents are required to hold an NRA Junior Family Membership (\$15/yr.; <https://joinnra.nra.org/join/Junior.aspx>) available from The NRA.
- Upon turning 18yrs of age, current youth members may convert to individual full club membership within 90 days of birthdate. A completed membership application, payment of the then current annual dues, and completion of all existing requirements of a new RPRC member is required. They will be exempt from paying the then current initiation/application fee.
- The requirement for administrative approvals from the school attended and requisite youth fee (independent youth membership) are waived.

NOTE: A distinction is made between this and the RPRC Youth Membership as described in RPRC by-laws. The individual Youth Membership is available to individuals between the ages of 12 and 17 yrs., not being dependents of current RPRC members.

### Range Rules: (adapted for use herein)

- Shooting allowed from 9am to sunset Mon-Sat and Sundays 1pm to sunset
- Ear and eye protection are mandatory while shooting
- Must visibly display membership ID badge when on club property
- Always consider firearms to be loaded and handle accordingly
- Always keep firearm pointed in a safe direction
- Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
- Always keep the firearm unloaded until ready to shoot
- Put all trash in trash cans
- No alcohol or drugs permitted on the range at any time
- Record names & rounds fired on log at each range used
- Hunting is not permitted at any time
- Incendiary, armor piercing and tracer ammunition are not permitted on the range
- Ammunition larger than .45 caliber and fully automatic firearms require special authorization
- When going down range make all firearms safe and no handling of firearms when anyone is down range
- Remove all used targets & place in trash cans
- See specific rules at each range

**Firearm Safety Course**

Upon mutual agreement with the parent/guardian, the Safety Officer/Director conducting the Orientation may require additional firearm safety training be required.
