Oregon Trail Ride - Registration Opens March 1

Come finish your road bike cycling season off with a ***12-day trip*** at the end of September that makes its way down the scenic Oregon Coast Bike Route. Our cycling journey begins in Astoria, Oregon and follows the Pacific coastline, heading through the Redwoods (Avenue of the Giants) and we finish with cycling across the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco completing approximately 1250 km. This is an advanced ride as we will average 104KM per day with a max of 130KM in one day, with two 400M good climbs. You will have time to check out great ocean views and numerous lighthouses along the way. Participants will make their own way with their bikes to Portland airport on September 19, where we will shuttle you to the route starting point. There will be two support vehicles to transport luggage, provide snacks/ lunch and aid as needed to riders. Accommodations and breakfast will be booked in hotels for the group with easy walking access to restaurants at night. We will finish the route in San Francisco with a night in hotel and final celebration dinner. Riders will be responsible for finding their own way home for themselves and their bikes or maybe you want to hang out longer and check out San Francisco. The routes are available on "ridewithgps" and the estimated cost is \$2200 based on double occupancy. There is a 10-rider minimum with a maximum capacity of 13 riders.

Registration for the trip opens March 1, 2020 at noon. To register, you must be an EBTC 2020 member and place a \$500 nonrefundable deposit.
