- 1. Rev Scott McAllister (UCC) has been inducted as the Moderator of Presbytery for a period of 2 years.

- 3. New Standing Orders for Presbytery's Committees have been approved and now need to be implemented.
- 4. The "Strategic Plan" of the Presbyterian Church in Canada was brought to the attention of Presbytery; details can be found on: https://presbyterian.ca/strategic-plan/
- 5. Presbytery has approved a process whereby contracted ministers (such as presently at Valetta, New St. Andrew's Dover, Knox Wallaceburg) and ruling elders involved in pastoral care can be nominated and trained (by Presbytery) to give the sacraments, under the annual review and close monitoring by their respective interim-moderator.
