9. Annual Reports to be submitted by January 31<sup>st</sup>!

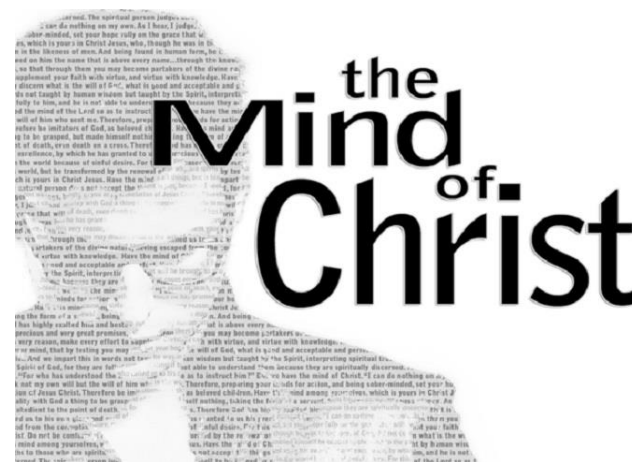
