News from Presbytery

1. At General Assembly this year (GA, June 2-6), after much prayerful discussion, the decision was made for the PCC to move towards "Inclusion," both in terms of re-defining marriage (2 definitions) and incorporating LGBTQI into the clergy. There is still a great deal of work to be done before GA 2020, when it is possible/likely that a final decision will be made. (There will be safeguards for 'liberty of conscience' for congregations, sessions, elders, and ministers.) Please pray for unity, wisdom, and grace at all levels within the PCC. 2. Presbytery received, with regret, the resignation Rev. Scott McAllister as minister of University Community Church (UCC), with effect from 30th Oct 2019. Rev. Dr. Tim Reddish was appointed as UCC's interim moderator, starting 1st Sept 2019. Pray for UCC as it transitions and seeks a new minister. (Tim ceases to be interim moderator of Valetta Presbyterian Church.)
3. Presbytery approved a \$3600 grant from the *Congregational Support Fund* for AV equipment for the needs of St Andrew's Sanctuary and the Church House Sessions. That's great news!


