Code of Conduct

I understand that accepting a spot in this troupe is contingent on meeting the following requirements:

1. Actors cannot miss more than **THREE** rehearsals, and **MUST** attend all rehearsals from tech weekend onwards. This includes any conflicts you note on the conflict sheet. Leaving a rehearsal early, or arriving late, counts as an absence. (Any additional requested absence must be communicated by the parent, and approved by the director.)
2. Because of the challenging material, actors are expected to memorize lines, dances, and songs outside of scheduled rehearsal time by designated off-book date.
3. During rehearsal, cell phones/laptops/electronics may **ONLY** be used during scheduled breaks, or to record songs/music during a music rehearsal. There may be no cell phone/laptop/electronic use in the theater at Lebanon Opera House, or thirty minutes before show time in the green room/dressing rooms, or during the shows.
4. Actors will be expected to show respect and professionalism to fellow actors, crew, and staff.
5. Actors must participate in community service that relates to our chosen charities.
6. Trumbull Hall Troupe has a zero-tolerance policy on substance use.

If at any point an actor violates one or more of these contractual requirements, the THT staff or Board of Directors has the right to remove him/her from a role or from the troupe. A meeting will be arranged with the student, the parents, and the Board and creative team prior to removal.
