

A COVID-19 Update - September 15, 2020

On September 20, Northside Baptist Church will resume our Sunday school program at 9:30 AM and will provide a children's church during our 10:30 AM worship service. A nursery will also be available. Because of the ongoing number of COVID-19 cases in our area, we believe it is best that we not regather on Sunday at 5:30 PM - at least through December 2020. We would continue to ask our attendees to wear face masks before and after the service when social distancing is not possible. Our rows are spaced out to allow for adequate social distancing when seated and standing by your chair.

Please review the recommendations we posted regarding our reopening service in May:

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19, NBC will implement these guidelines: The church requests that people wear masks.

The church will place hand sanitizers at the entrances. Please use (or your own bottle of hand sanitizer) upon entering and exiting the auditorium.

We would ask that families sit together and maintain social distancing between other families when seated. Chairs will be arraigned to help you keep your distance. Parents, please have your children with you at all times.

We encourage everyone to bring a water bottle and fill them using our new water fountains.

Offering plates will be replaced by a box at the back of our auditorium. We encourage our members to utilize the ability to give online.

Older adults and people who have underlying medical conditions like heart or lung disease or diabetes seem to be at higher risk for developing more serious complications from COVID-19 illness. We encourage our members who are high risk to stay home and watch our service online.

Please stay home when you or someone in your household is sick (i.e., fevered, consistent cough, runny nose, aches, sore throat or any other virus symptoms). In the case of sickness please join online instead.

Until further notice, the church choir will not rehearse or sing in the services.
