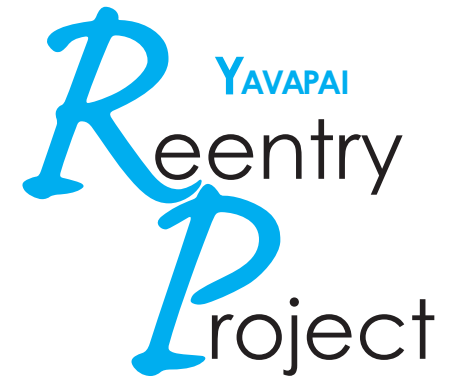
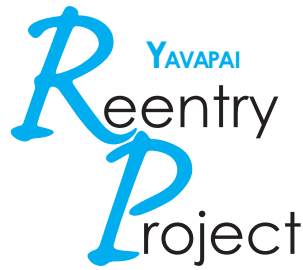

What is the Yavapai Reentry Project?

The Yavapai Reentry Project works with many organizations across the County to help create opportunities for formerly incarcerated individuals returning to communities throughout Yavapai County to find support, healthy relationships, and hope for their futures.

What Programs Are Offered?

1) Independent Referral Program

Offers participants case-plan management services and referrals to community resources. The Yavapai Reentry Project staff completes monthly check-ins with participants over the phone and through email and supports participants while goals are completed.

2) Community Coach Mentorship Program*

Offers participants case-plan management and placement with a coach trained to provide referrals to community resources, assist with goal completion and provide emotional support.

*Sex offenders do not qualify for this program.

How Do I Join?

To be a part of the Yavapai Reentry Project, you must be 18 or older and:

- Returning from a state-level correctional facility or were released in the last three months.
- Returning to a community in Yavapai County.

To provide the best services possible, we recommend completing all necessary paperwork before your release.
