The Worthley Pond LakeSmart 2021 program started off with success as we awarded our first sign to **Lisa and Dave Ellis** of 121 East Shore Road. Congrats!!



In 2018, the Worthley Pond Association achieved GOLD POND status, established by Maine Lakes, in recognition that at least 15% of the properties on the pond are LakeSmart certified.
