2020 COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

The following COVID-19 guidelines and protocols must be adhered to when competing and/or attending our competitions. In addition, all Federal, State, and local laws that may be applicable must be followed. Management reserves the right to change the guidelines and protocols when/if necessary. Failure to follow guidelines may result in expulsion from the show grounds.

If you plan to come to the competition grounds, you must be able to assure management that neither you, nor anyone in your household has tested positive or been presumed positive for COVID-19 or has been advised to quarantine in the last 14 days. Additionally, that you or any household members have not in the last 24 hours had a fever greater than 100.4, a cough or shortness of breath.

The following protocols are MANDATORY to be on the show grounds:

1. Social Distancing must be followed at all times. Current guidelines call for 6' minimum spacing between individuals. In any instance where 6' spacing cannot be guaranteed, it is recommended that a mask or cloth face covering is used.
2. Do NOT gather in large groups.
3. Show grounds are only open to trainers, riders, grooms, owners, competition staff and parents attending as a minor's guardian. No spectators, extended family or friends on the show grounds at this time.
4. Please do not crowd the ingate areas, Secretary Stand, Concessions, Schooling areas/jumps, Bathrooms or Course Boards. Maintain social distance and follow signage and markings that help direct traffic flow.
5. Round pen gate and schooling jumps will have a spray bottles of QUAT disinfecting spray accessible. Any touch points at these locations MUST be sprayed off if you have touched them. This disinfecting spray is safe for humans and animals.
6. In the parking areas, please do your part to park and set up while maintaining social distance from the trailers and cars around you. Staff will periodically check these areas and you may be asked to move if you are not properly distanced. Please consider this before parking and setting up your area and before parking next to someone else.
7. For safety reasons we will NOT be providing water coolers and cups at the rings like we normally do. Please be sure to supply your own water/beverages to stay hydrated. The Concessions provider will also have bottled water for sale.
8. We WILL provide concessions through our two vendor partner food trucks, both of which are excellent at following all necessary protocols as well, however, opting to purchase food from these vendors is at your own risk.
9. There will be a hand washing station available next to the bathroom facilities, and hand sanitizer located conveniently around the show grounds including at the Secretary Stand. Please follow good hygiene practices and frequently wash hands or use sanitizer. We will also have spray bottles of QUAT disinfecting spray around the grounds as well.
10. Please use trash receptacles so that staff does not have to come in contact with contaminated items that are not discarded properly. Receptacles are located all around the show grounds. DO NOT LITTER! This is a facility wide rule, including out in the parking areas!!!! Think ahead, bring a trash bag to use at your trailer!
11. Trainers will be held responsible for the conduct and adherence to the guidelines and protocols set forth during competition. Trainers and/or barns are subject to expulsion from the grounds if guidelines are not followed. Please discuss with each individual in your group the importance of following these guidelines and protocols.
