What is an EMT?

In the field of emergency medical services (EMS), emergency medical technicians (EMTs) are critically important. Often the very first patient contact in an emergency, they are a critical partner to other healthcare professionals.

In an emergency situation, EMTs determine the nature and severity of injuries and transfer the patient in a well-equipped vehicle. They inform the hospital about the patient's injuries and illnesses as well as monitoring the patient's condition until they can safely deliver them to the hospital.

EMTs are often sent to emergency sites by 911 operators, where they might work alongside firefighters and the police.

They are also critically important in transporting non-emergency, medically appropriate patients as they move between healthcare settings or upon their discharge from the hospital.
