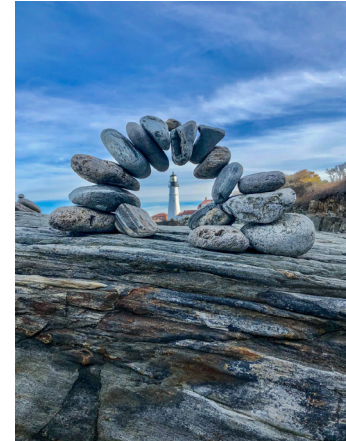

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Artists are asked to submit up to three digital images for the jury process.

Images must be in jpg format, no larger than 1000 pixels on the longest side at 300 dpi and at least 1MB in size.

NATURE IN BALANCE

An Exhibition Featuring Artwork Related to the Calming Effect of the Natural World in all Traditional Media

February 19 - April 4, 2020

- Artist must be an Arizona resident at least 18 years old.
- Artwork must be original.
- Artwork cannot exceed 5 feet in height, 4 feet in width
- Artwork cannot exceed 150 lbs (pedestal display) or 50 lbs (hanging display)
- Larger, more complex artworks will require installation assistance by the artist
- Artwork accepted for the exhibition to be displayed on wall must be ready to hang with a wire on back, taut, approximately 1/3 of the way from the top so that wire does not show or pull above frame when hung. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted.
- Canvases should be wrapped or framed without glass. Art framed under glass must use museum-quality, plexiglass or single-strength glass (no non-glare). Framed work should not weigh more than 50 lbs.
- All artwork submitted must have been created within the last two years.
- Artwork cannot have been previously included in an exhibition at the Shemer Art Center.
