

## ABOUT THE JURORS

**Ann Morton** has been a full-time, practicing artist since earning her MFA in 2012. She has shown her work nationally and internationally, had several public art commissions, and has shown work in several publications including *American Craft* and *Surface Design Journal*. Many of Ann's large-scale projects have a community based focus, which add another layer of meaning and depth to her work. She is currently showing "The Violet Protest," a public engagement project at the Phoenix Art Museum as the recipient of the 2019 Arlene and Morton Scult Artist Award.

**Roger Asay** and collaborator Rebecca Davis have been working together since 1983 on a body of work they call *WOOD AND STONE: SUBSTANCE AND SPIRIT*. Their work draws upon the raw matter of nature. Their work has been shown in numerous exhibitions across the southwest in museums and galleries. They are also known for site-specific land art and earth art, as well as wood constructions and public art. Roger's work is included in many public and corporate collections such as the U.S. Park Service and New Mexico Museum of Fine Art



## ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

The Shemer Art Center is now accepting applications from Arizona artists who create primarily in fiber and wood for this upcoming juried exhibition.

Selected works will be dynamic creations made of natural and synthetic materials and vary in color, texture, and design. Works will convey both aesthetic value and utilitarian function.

## MEDIA

---

All entries for this exhibition must be constructed primarily of wood and fiber media. All art must be original.

## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

---

Artists are asked to submit up to three digital images for the jury process. Images must be in jpg format, no larger than 1000 pixels on the longest side at 300 dpi and at least 1MB in size. Title each image in this format:

## CREATIVE KNOTS

## EXHIBITION DETAILS

---

- Artist must be an Arizona resident at least 18 years old.
- Artwork must be original.
- Artwork cannot exceed 5 feet in height, 4 feet in width
- Artwork cannot exceed 150 lbs (pedestal display) or 50 lbs (hanging display)
- Larger, more complex artworks will require installation assistance by the artist
- Artwork accepted hanging must be ready to hang with a wire on back, taut, approximately 1/3 of the way from the top so that wire does not show or pull above frame when hung. No entries with sawtooth hangers will be accepted.
- Canvases should be wrapped or framed without glass. Art framed under glass must use museum-quality, plexiglass or single-strength glass (no non-glare). Framed work should not weigh more than 50 lbs.
- All artwork submitted must have been created within the last two years and cannot have been previously included in an exhibition at the Shemer Art Center.

## SALES

---

Artists who sell their work should expect to receive 70% of the sale price, with 30% retained by the Shemer Art Center. All works are encouraged to be available for purchase. However, if works are not available for sale, please indicate NFS (not for sale) on your entry.

All artwork will be insured by Shemer Art Center for the duration of the exhibit. Prior arrangements for the installation of large-scale sculpture must be made in advance and approved by the Executive Director.
