

## ABOUT THE JUROR

**Mary Meyer**, a resident of Gold Canyon, AZ, creates artwork that has a strong connection to the environment and nature. She states, "I create sculptural works that focus on the essential need for stillness, connection and recognition. I use materials like clay, metal, wood, and intuitive methods such as carving and hand building to explore how the human form impacts—and is mirrored within—the landscape."

Meyer recently received the Pat Mutterer Award presented at the 2020 Arizona Biennial at the Tucson Museum of Art. In 2016, she received the prestigious Phoenix Art Museum's Contemporary Forum Artist Grant and exhibited her work there. In 2019, Meyer had works featured in a solo exhibition at Mesa Contemporary Art Museum titled, *Biophilia*.

Mary holds a BFA from Arizona State University and an MFA from University of Arizona and has had works featured in national and international collections.

## ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

---

The Shemer Art Center is now accepting entries from Arizona artists who create artwork that is only black and white for this upcoming juried exhibition.

Selected works will be created in all media, including but not limited to, painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, ceramics, wood, metal, fiber and glass. Works can be functional or simply explore concepts of form, value, texture, contrast, pattern, and repetition.

## MEDIA

---

All entries for this exhibition must be black and white, ONLY. The exhibition is open to all media and all art must be original.

## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

---

Artists are asked to submit up to three digital images for the jury process. Images must be in jpg format, no larger than 1000 pixels on the longest side at 300 dpi and at least 1MB in size. Title each image in this format:

# ONLY BLACK & WHITE

*An exhibition to be juried by Mary Meyer of black and white works of art, ONLY, created in all mediums.*

## EXHIBITION DETAILS

---

- Artist must be an Arizona resident at least 18 years old.
- Artwork must be original.
- Artwork cannot exceed 5 feet in height, 4 feet in width
- Artwork cannot exceed 100 lbs (pedestal display) or 50 lbs (hanging display)
- Larger, more complex artworks will require installation assistance by the artist
- Artwork accepted hanging must be ready to hang with a wire on back, taut, approximately 1/3 of the way from the top so that wire does not show or pull above frame when hung. No entries with sawtooth hangers will be accepted.
- Canvases should be wrapped or framed without glass. Art framed under glass must use museum-quality, plexiglass or single-strength glass (no non-glare). Framed work should not weigh more than 50 lbs.
- All artwork submitted must have been created within the last two years and cannot have been previously included in an exhibition at the Shemer Art Center.

## SALES

---

Artists who sell their work should expect to receive 70% of the sale price, with 30% retained by the Shemer Art Center. All works are encouraged to be available for purchase. However, if works are not available for sale, please indicate NFS (not for sale) on your entry.

All artwork will be insured by Shemer Art Center for the duration of the exhibit. Prior arrangements for the installation of large-scale sculpture must be made in advance and approved by the Executive Director.
