

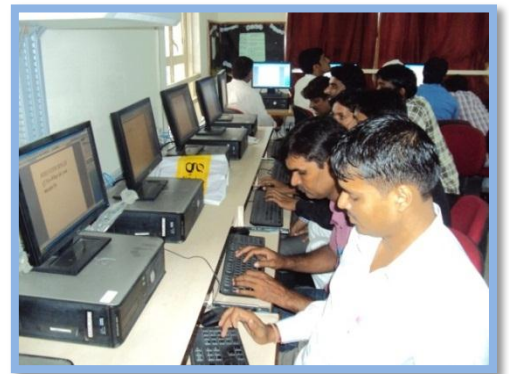


MEWAT RURAL EDUCATION PROGRAM (MREP)

Reinventing Education Teacher Training

Continuing effort to bring transformation in 47 schools in 19 villages in Mewat, we have successfully conducted 23 training sessions targeting 62 teachers since July in collaboration with Sarva Shiksha Abhiyaan (SSA) & Department of Elementary Education (DEE). Along with teacher training; regular IT training, exposure visits, establishing collaborative platform, sharing of best practices among teachers, rewarding and showing their effort is cohesively being practiced.

The program is also ensuring its implementation at school level by regular onsite support by program coordinator and we are delighted to see that 67% of teachers have initiated to bring change. We appreciate their self-motivation and salute those who all are looking forward to help their community. The teachers are keeping up the zeal to bring revolution in their schools.

Avishkar Mobile Science Van visited 43 schools wherein 5011 students participated. Teacher's participation also played a crucial role in orienting students' zeal towards science education and making it an integral part of the school curriculum.

Completion of 1st batch of Electrician Training Program

The 1st batch has recently completed their training module and 17 students out of 30 have successfully completed it. Their certification, placement and entrepreneurship facilitation is being done. This program will definitely benefit the youth belonging to the bottom of the pyramid to shape up their livelihood.

Spoken English Program (Teach India) 4th batch completed

SRF Foundation in collaboration with **The Times of India** has completed **4th batch** of **TEACH INDIA** program. It is a course in spoken English for X and XII pass youth from the marginalized section of the society. A total of **60 boys** from Nuh block and project villages have been trained in this batch. Recently a job fair was organized by Times of India in Delhi wherein, out of 17 aspiring candidates 9 have been offered jobs in the hospitality sectors and call centres, in Gurgaon, Delhi and nearby area.





Smart Quality Checker Program students got placement in Export House

With an objective to provide employability to the rural youth this program was initiated in collaboration with Apparel Training and Design Centre, Nuh. This program is sponsored by the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India.

20 interested students were trained for 2 months under this training program. Recently, a few students from the batch have got campus placement in the export house, while others are in the pipeline. This training program substantially helps these aspiring youth in finding out the way of life.

The Enhancing Early Education Program welcomed the batch of 21 students on the 5th of November 2012 with two days of fun filled orientation. The final evaluation of 36 students of July-December batch occurred in the last week of December

The students of the current batch had a very enriching experience of interacting with the children of the Aanganwadi and other schools in Mewat, where they conducted story telling sessions and action rhymes; much to the pleasure of the little ones. The 3EP Facilitators have successfully conducted teacher training workshops on understanding children, classroom norms and creativity for the MREP teachers. As part of the ongoing in-service program, workshops are being held for the teachers of the Pardada Pardadi Educational Society, Anupshahr and the teachers of The Shri Early Years, Gurgaon.
