



# 2021 Irvine Summertime Classic

## COVID Protocols & Procedures

### 1. PROTOCOLS & PROCEDURES

- a. Please use common sense and your best judgment throughout the tournament to protect the Health & Safety of all participants in the 2021 Irvine Summertime Classic.

### 2. SYMPTOMATIC – STAY HOME!

- a. If anyone associated with your team (players, coaches, team parents, immediate household members) exhibits Covid-like symptoms, tests positive, or has been in contact with a Covid-positive/symptomatic person within the 14 days prior to your first game, please tell them to stay home.

### 3. PRE-GAME

- a. Each coach/parent should conduct a temperature check for their players/child as well as for all on-field personnel prior to warm-ups. Stay home or leave the facility immediately if anyone has a temperature above 100.4 degrees or is symptomatic.
- b. Administer contact questionnaire.
- c. Sanitize – Before/During/After game. Wipes and sanitizer will be provided to each team at check-in (but you are **HIGHLY** encouraged to bring your own as well).
- d. Do not arrive more than 1 hour prior to the scheduled game time.

### 4. MASKS

- a. **On-Field Players** (Defensive Players, Batter, Base Runner(s), On-Deck Batter)
  - i. Not required/Optional.
- b. **Everyone Else** (Coaches, Team Parent, Spectators, Players on Bench/in Dugout both on offense and on defense).
  - i. Mandatory at all times (even if vaccinated).

### 5. DUGOUTS

- a. Wipe dugouts/benches/fence door handles/bat racks, etc., both prior to and following each game.
- b. Everyone may be in the dugout with masks on.
- c. If you choose to spread out your team into stands or down the lines/in the outfield **out of play**, you may do so.



## 6. EQUIPMENT

- a. Do not share individual equipment.
- b. Sanitize any equipment that may need to be shared (catcher's gear, etc.).

## 7. FOOD & DRINKS

- a. Do not share any food, drinks, snacks or bottles.

## 8. SPECTATORS

- a. Player dispersion to the stands will take precedence over spectator seating.
- b. Maintain 6 feet of separation from people not from your immediate household.
- c. Spectators **MUST** wear masks at all times (even if vaccinated).
- d. Spectators are encouraged to bring chairs and sit, properly spaced, behind the outfield fence or in the outfield down the foul lines **out of play** (with the exception of completely enclosed fields (CBB-1; HCAP 5, 6 & 7; PS-1 & 2; all GP fields).
- e. Spectators should sanitize their hands upon arriving at the field.

## 9. POST-GAME

- a. No handshake line between teams.
- b. All post-game ceremonies should take place in the outfield immediately following the conclusion of the game.
- c. Conduct a socially distant cheer for the other team in the outfield.
- d. Wave to your opponent from a safe distance.
- e. Please leave the facility immediately following the end of your game.
