Series End Points System and Important Info

Entry fees are non-refundable. Classes in the lead line division are \$20 per class. All other divisions are \$30 per class plus horse fees. The grand Prix and Pony Prix are \$40 to enter

Consult your trainer before filling out an entry blank so they can place you in the right division for you and your horse's skill level.

Riders will be judged on the criteria stated in the following prize list.

Classes may be divided into sections depending on the number of entries for each class and horse availability.

The scoring of ribbons for every class except those in the Lead Line Division is as follows:

- First Place- 7 Points
- Second Place- 5 Points
- Third Place- 4 Points
- Fourth Place- 3 Points
- Fifth Place- 2 Points
- Sixth Place- 1 Point

Series end ribbons and prizes are to be presented at the series end, potluck dinner at Echo Farm on the date of June 9, 2019. All riders of the Echo Farm community are invited and encouraged to attend regardless of their participation in the Echo Farm Spring Show Series or their expected placing in said show series. There will be good food and good company!

Sportsmanship is an important part of riding and is valued very much at Echo Farm. There will be a series- end Sportsmanship Award awarded to any rider of the Echo Farm community who showed outstanding support and helpfulness to fellow riders and horses.

Prize List

Lead Line Division

This division is open to young riders who have just begun their riding careers, ribbons to be presented after each class. Riders may be asked to demonstrate a trot or jog.

1. Lead Line
2. Lead Line (may be asked to trot)

Walk Trot/ Jog Division

This division is open to riders capable of walking and posting the trot without the help of a lead line.

3. Walk Trot Equitation- diagonals not to count
4. Walk Trot Equitation- diagonals to count

Walk Trot Canter Division

This division is open to riders capable of demonstrating the walk, trot, and canter, with diagonals and leads to count. Equitation flat and jumping are to be judged on position of rider and their control over their mount. Hunters to be judged on the movement of the mount. Poles class open to riders capable of cantering poles.

5. Walk Trot Canter Equitation
6. Walk Trot Canter Hunters
7. Cantering Poles Equitation (twice around)

Adult Division

This division is open to all riders and horses and is to be judged on the horse's demeanor and how pleasurable it looks to ride. Open to both English and Western riders and horses.

8. Adult Walk Trot Pleasure
9. Adult Walk Trot Equitation
10. Adult Walk Trot Canter
11. Adult Cross Rails

Cross Rails Division

This division is open to all riders capable of cantering cross rails in a pattern or twice around. Equitation flat and jumping are to be judged on position of rider and their control over their mount. Hunters to be judged on the movement of the mount.

12. Hunt Seat Equitation on the Flat
13. Hunter Under Saddle
14. Cross Rail Equitation
15. Cross Rail Hunters

Schooling Hunters/ Equitation

This division is open to riders capable of demonstrating a course of 6-8 fences at a height of 2' or less. Equitation flat and jumping are to be judged on position of rider and their control over their mount. Hunters to be judged on the movement of the mount.

16. Schooling Equitation Over Fences
17. Schooling Hunters Over Fences
18. Schooling Equitation on the Flat
19. Schooling Hunters on the Flat

Child/ Adult Modified Hunters/ Equitation

This division is open to riders capable of demonstrating a course of 6-8 fences at a height of 2'6" with oxers. Equitation flat and jumping are to be judged on position of rider and their control over their mount.

Hunters to be judged on the movement of the mount.

20. Modified Equitation on the Flat
21. Modified Hunters on the Flat
22. Modified Equitation Over Fences
23. Modified Hunters Over Fences

Open Hunters/ Equitation

This division is open to any horse or rider capable of demonstrating a course of 6-8 fences at any height between 2'9" and 3'3". Equitation flat and jumping are to be judged on position of rider and their control over their mount. Hunters to be judged on the movement of the mount.

24. Open Hunters Under Saddle
25. Open Equitation on the Flat
26. Open Hunters Over Fences
27. Open Equitation Over Fences (test to be administered if judge feels it is necessary)
