These community networks jointly engage by working in spheres of conflict resolution, reconciliation, environmental sustainability, health, education, women empowerment, youth engagement, advocacy for human rights, etc.

Internships:

This form consists of three different positions. Please go through the description of each position carefully before going ahead with the application process. Guidelines and the documents required for each position are mentioned below.

We are looking for someone who is keen on working for interfaith organisations on the lines of youth and women empowerment, tolerance and harmony, peace and conflict management, secularism and equality in terms of gender and religion.

1. Artist/Illustrator

- As an illustrator you will be **responsible for creating illustrations, comic strips, cartoon caricatures, images about festivals and important cultural and religious events for the blog and social media pages.**
- You will get the due credit for your work on the social media pages and the blog.
- The internship will be for a minimum period of 1 month. The internship period is extendable if the applicant wishes to continue, given the performance and dedication of the applicant. A Letter of Completion will be given to all interns. A Letter of Recommendation by the Regional Coordinator will be given for exceptional performance.
- This is a part-time internship.

- Interns will be given the opportunity to participate in additional trainings/workshops from time to time to upskill their work; and might be asked to volunteer for special programs.
- In order to apply for the internship, please submit your Resume along with a PDF of your sample work.

2. Social Media Intern

- Manage social media pages of the organisation on different platforms along with the social media manager.
- Create content for social media pages
- Engage in social media outreach
- Engage with the work of our Cooperation Circles on social media pages.
- The internship will be for a minimum period of 1 month. The internship period is extendable if the applicant wishes to continue, given the performance and dedication of the applicant. A Letter of Completion will be given to all interns. A Letter of Recommendation by the Regional Coordinator will be given for exceptional performance.
- This is a part-time internship.
- Interns will be given the opportunity to participate in additional trainings/workshops from time to time to upskill their work; and might be asked to volunteer for special programs.
- In order to apply for the internship, please submit your Resume along with a statement of purpose (not more than 300 words).

3. Photography Intern

- As a photographer for the blog & social media pages, you will be responsible for clicking and editing photographs on a particular theme.
- You will also be responsible for submitting photo essays during your tenure-ship.
- Your work will be published on our blog, newsletter and social media. Due credit for the work and recognition will be given.
- This is a part time internship.
