We have four different, individual membership options available to select from:

Professional - Individuals who are engaged in the profession of human resources management within the public sector, or engaged in public sector work providing services to public sector employees. *Professional members will have full rights and privileges to vote, hold office and chair committees.*

Associate - Individuals that work outside of the public sector, who can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Executive Board a bona fide interest in: (1) human resources management or providing benefits/ services to employees, and (2) promoting the objectives and programs of this Chapter. *Associate members may vote and chair committees, but cannot hold office.*

Student - Individuals who are currently enrolled in a course of study related to human resources management or public administration at an accredited college or university in the State of Arkansas. *Student members may not vote, hold office or chair committees.*

Emeritus - Individuals who were active Chapter members for at least five (5) consecutive years, and are retired from full-time employment within the public sector of human resources management. *Emeritus members shall retain the same rights and privileges of Associate members, and will not be required to pay annual membership dues.*
