COVID-19 and Your Safety

As a notary service we have been deemed “Essential Business” by The US Treasury and The California Secretary of State. We service financial, medical, and other important industries that keep the United States Critical Infrastructure Sectors in working order. Please consider the risks of COVID-19 found at www.cdc.gov before scheduling.

We are operating with safety in mind.

For your health and the safety of others, we have limited our daily interactions. We will be providing new pens for signing, sanitizing our equipment regularly, washing our hands often, wearing face masks, providing hand sanitizing wipes, ensuring distance during signings, and streamlining your appointment for time-efficient visits.

We also ask you take all the precautions you need for your own personal care and safety at this time.

We encourage you to prepare for a safe visit:

- **We encourage a mask or bandana at the time of signing**
- **Please wash your hands before and after your appointment.**
- **We encourage setting up a safe and easy signing space.**
(Examples include a front porch, open garage, and/or a large table)
- **Provide us with documents in advance for a fast meeting.**
provide us your documents via email or a photo so that we can prepare and double check our journals/certificates beforehand.

- **Have your ID ready and be mindful of notary prerequisites found at www.sdsignings.com/notary-appointment/**
- **Documents should have no blanks and be completed in full before the appointment.**
- **Be safe! Have your own personal protective plan.**
We encourage you to consider your own safety plan that ensures you feel safe. Other signers have been mindful of their personal protective measures by having personal hand sanitizers, etc. We believe in safety first!
