## Bank of Italy Opens New San Rafael Building Tonight With Ceremonies

One of the most beautiful and commodious bank buildings in the north coast counties is to be opened by the Bank of Italy on Fourth street in San Rafael today with appropriate ceremonies from 7 o'clock until 10 this evening. The building will be opened for business on Monday.

Every modern device that could be utilized to enhance the banking facilities and every feature that could truly add to the beauty and utility of the structure have been blended in the San Rafael building scheme. The architecture is of the later Italian Renaissance, with

a striking symbolic plaque arrangement on the exterior to carry the names and the symbols of the bank.

According to the chronicles Major Newell Vanderbilt, a leading historian of the San Rafael region, the bank is located on the site of the second structure to be erected in San Rafael. This was an adobe building, reared early in the last century and used for a time as the headquarters of General Fremont, the Pathfinder of California history, it was replaced in 1876 by the Centennial building, the first brick building to be reared north of San Francisco.

The Centennial building was used for a time as a bank. It was this structure that was torn down to make way for the Bank of Italy building.

Henry S. Foote, veteran banker of Marin county and one of the foremost figures in the development of that section, has acted as manager of the Bank of Italy branch since its establishment as successor to the Tamalpais Bank, of which Foote was president. A number of his ideas have gone into the new building.
