COVID 19 PROCEDURES FOR FAMILIES AND STAFF

- Upon arrival, STAFF AND CAMPERS will be given a daily health assessment, including temperature screening and symptom checking, which will be logged by the early-late director or the nurse. Any STAFF member OR CAMPER with a fever of 100 degrees or higher or showing symptoms of Covid19 will be sent home. Symptoms of Covid19 can include: shortness of breath, cough, fever, breathing difficulty, loss of taste or smell, headache, muscle aches, chills, sore throat, diarrhea, nausea, runny nose and fatigue.
- ◆ Campers and staff <u>must</u> stay at home if they are ill. If they are ill with Covid19 symptoms, a Covid19 test with a negative result needs to be submitted to the camp before returning. The camp nurse will determine if and when the camper or staff member may return.
- If a staff member or camper tests positive for Covid19, we will alert anyone who the staff member or camper has come in contact with. We will also alert all parents and staff members that someone in the camp has tested positive. They will be further instructed to monitor themselves for Covid19 symptoms. If a camper or staff member is showing signs of Covid19, they must contact the camp immediately. Campers or staff members showing signs must stay home from camp and isolate. If a camper or staff member show Covid19 symptoms during the camp day, they will report to the nurse for isolation and sent home.
- If a camper or staff member tests positive for Covid19 the entire camp grounds will be cleaned and disinfected.

- MASKS will be worn by staff during the camp day. The exception to staff wearing a mask would be when they are eating or doing physical activity. Staff will practice social distancing when eating or doing physical activity.
- Campers (over the age of two) and staff will be required to bring two face masks to camp for indoor activities or rainy days as an extra precaution.
 There is sufficient indoor space and an outdoor 30 x 50 tent for inclement weather conditions.
- Staff will wear gloves & masks during diaper changing.
- ♦ Disposable gloves will be worn by cleaning and snack staff
- Daily cleaning will occur in all areas of our facility. Sanitizing will be done
 with disinfecting cleaner and used according to manufacturer's instructions.
 - Communal spaces on a daily basis
 - Shared items or equipment between uses
 - Frequently touched surfaces multiple times per day
 - Change areas daily
- Spray cleaner and disinfectant wipes will be located at all specialty areas to be used on the equipment between lessons.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in a variety of locations throughout the camp grounds.
- Campers and staff will be reminded frequently to wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Staff will assist our younger campers.
 - Upon arrival
 - Before eating
 - After eating
 - Upon entering change area
 - o After touching frequently touched surfaces
 - After using restroom
 - After using sports equipment

- After coughing, sneezing or blowing nose
- Before and after using community equipment
- ◆ The pool will continue to be treated with all necessary chemicals to maintain a safe swimming environment for all.
 - Campers to wash hands before and after swimming
 - Adequate staffing will be maintained
 - Social distancing will be observed and each group will have the same instructor
 - o Frequently touched surfaces will be disinfected multiple times per day
 - Chlorine levels will remain at 5-8 ppm
- ◆ Parents or guardians will be required to wear a face mask when entering the camp office or nurses office should they need to sign a camper in or out.
- Physical distancing of 6 feet will be practiced at all times during the camp day:
 - o Groups will maintain the ratio of 1 counselor to 10 campers
 - We will not mix groups
 - We have a staggered arrival and dismissal procedure. All of our campers are dropped off and picked up by their parents between the hours of 7:00am and 9:00am in the morning and 4:00pm and 6:00pm in the afternoon. Parents arrive at various times during those time periods.
