2020 - 2021 ANSW State Team Selection Policy

| Background | This document will cover team selection for archers to compete and represent Archery NSW in ANSW Youth and Senior teams at both the 2020 and 2021 National Championships Youth and Senior. |
| Purpose | The purpose of this selection criteria for both Youth and Senior Archery NSW teams, is to select the best available teams of both male and female archers for State Representation at the relevant Archery Australia National competitions. |
| Eligibility | All archers applying for, and /or obtaining a place in either the Youth or Senior ANSW team, must be a financial member of Archery Australia both at time of application, up to and including the duration of competition at the relevant National event. |
| The “Team” Definition | The ‘Team’ means the team which is selected by Archery NSW which includes Archers and may also include Coaches, Team Manager. |
| Expression of Interest (EOI) | Current team members from both the Senior and Youth teams will be placed on the next year’s EOI list. They will need to notify the ANSW Coaching Coordinator if they wish to opt out of selection. All other archers interested in being part of the ANSW teams, must email their EOI to either the Youth Coordinator or Coaching Coordinator at ANSW before end of selection period. |
| Participation Requirements | <p>Archers accepting a place in the ANSW team must shoot all rounds as required by the National Championships team competition rules .</p> <p>Team Members must use the same bow type for the duration of the event, as per the team they have been selected for, across all the required disciplines.</p> <p>Currently, these are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Youth- Target, Field and Clout • Senior - Target and Field. |

| | <p>Senior Team archers of Master age division and above, who wish to compete for the Best All Round, will need to shoot Clout as well.</p> <p>Archery Australia may update the rules for team competition before the Nationals begin, please check Rules as included in the event entry forms.</p> |
| Allocated Places | <p><u>Youth Team</u> There will be 10 team members in each of the Youth Compound and Recurve teams.</p> <p>Available places in the team will be based on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5 places for Target, regardless of gender;• 3 places for Field, regardless of gender; and• 2 places for Clout, regardless of gender <p>If an explanation of the 5:3:2 team makeup is required, please email: youthcoordinator@archerynsw.org.au</p> <p><u>Senior Team</u> Senior teams will consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Compound - 4 males and 4 females.• Recurve - 4 males and 4 females. <p><u>Barebow / Longbow</u> Currently ANSW & AVIC are finalising the continuance of the interstate trophy for this team. The Barebow / Longbow Team is an Honorary Senior team only and does not participate in the Archery Australia Teams event.</p> <p>The Barebow / Longbow Team will consist of 4 members only, of any gender, utilizing only those bow types described across the whole competition (field, target & clout).</p> <p>Selection of a team will only take place once AVIC has confirmed they will be taking part in that year.</p> |

| Further Conditions of State Team Acceptance | <p>Any archers accepting Recurve or Compound team selection will be asked to note that a condition of acceptance is compulsory attendance at the presentation dinner. Those who fail to attend without prior permission from the ANSW Team Manager will not be reimbursed their entry fee.</p> <p>Archers attending the Presentation Dinner will be required to bring their NSW state jacket which is expected to be worn during presentations and photographs.</p> <p>The Presentation Dinner costs will be reimbursed by ANSW.</p> <p>All archers must sign a State Team Acceptance Agreement. A link to the on-line form will be sent by the coaching/youth coordinator.</p> |
| Team Accommodation | <p><u>Youth Team</u></p> <p>ANSW will try where possible to book reasonably priced accommodation for the team and their families in a central location. (e.g. Big4 tourist park). Staying in the Team camp for the duration of the National Competition is not compulsory. We expect that all Youth archers attending camp will be supportive and inclusive of both their team mates & other NSW archers.</p> <p>Youth team members are required to fund their own travel costs and accommodation costs if staying outside the team camp.</p> <p><u>Senior team</u></p> <p>Senior team members are required to fund their own travel and accommodation costs.</p> |
| Selection Qualifying Period | <p><u>Youth Team</u></p> <p>The Youth selection qualifying period for 2020 begins 1st January 2019 and closes 22nd. December 2019. The team will be announced late December 2019.</p> |

| | <p>The 2021 selection period starts 1st January 2020 and closes 30th November 2020, with the team to be announced mid December 2020.</p> <p><u>Senior Team</u></p> <p>The Senior selection qualifying period for 2020 begins 1st July 2019 and closes 30th June 2020. The team will be announced mid July 2020.</p> <p>The 2021 selection period will start 1st July 2020 and close 30th June 2021, with the team to be announced mid July 2021.</p> |
| <p>Selection Criteria</p> | <p>Following the closing date of qualifying period, all archers who have submitted an EOI will be considered for selection based on total ratings for their best 8 events shot during the selection periods.</p> <p>In the event of a shortfall of archers to make up a full team, the Team selectors at that time reserve the right to select archers, based on performance, at their discretion.</p> <p>Applicable rounds and events for selection:</p> <p>Target: 720 rounds - AA 30/720, AA 40/720, AA50/720, WA 50/720, WA 60/720, WA 70/720. 900 rounds – WA 60/900, Short Canberra, Youth Canberra. 1440 rounds - AA 40/1440, AA 50/1440, WA 60/1440, WA 70/1440, WA 90/1440.</p> <p>Clout: AA 100m, AA 125m, AA 145m, AA 165m, AA 180m.</p> <p>Field: WA marked 24T - Yellow, Blue or Red peg.</p> <p>All archers must shoot in at least TWO of the ANSW State Championship events for consideration for selection. Verified International scores and verified Interstate scores will be accepted.</p> |

| | <p>All rounds must be shot at an AA registered event, run to the appropriate WA or AA rules.</p> <p>Scores will be taken from Archers Diary. Adjusted scores will be calculated if an archer shoots outside of their age division.</p> |
| <p>Appeals</p> | <p>Where an archer considers that his/her non selection in the team has occurred because of a failure to follow these Selection Criteria the archer can lodge an appeal.</p> <p>Appeals should be made following the Archery NSW Appeals Policy that is current at the time of the announcement. Any appeal must be lodged within 2 weeks of Team announcement.</p> |
| <p>Injury and replacement</p> | <p>Once Team selections have been ratified by the Archery NSW Board, all Team Members accepting their selection thereby agree to disclose as soon as practicable all information relating to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. training fitness 2. injury 3. Illness <p>... where this has the potential to adversely affect training or competition at any time up until and including participation at the National Championship.</p> <p>All selected archers must at all times declare any medications they are taking, in particular the use of any restricted medications and submit these to the Archery NSW Coaching Coordinator by email to coaching@archerynsw.org.au</p> <p>At any stage following the selection announcement should there be any doubt about the ability of an archer to compete to the best of his/her ability due to an injury and/or illness, the following procedure will be adhered to:</p> <p>At the sole discretion of the Archery NSW Committee the archer will be referred to an Archery NSW designated Medical Officer to undergo a medical examination (at the archer's expense) to determine his/her fitness to participate, which at this stage will be determined based on an assessment of whether or not the injury and/or illness is such that the archer is physically unable to compete or is a risk of causing medical harm to him/herself, or endangering others.</p> |

| Announcement of Team Selection | <p>Selected Team Members shall agree not to make any announcement to the media or public in any form (including on any social media or personal websites) regarding their selection until after Archery NSW has published the Team selection.</p> <p>Archery NSW will publicly announce the team as soon as possible following the ratification of the team by the Archery NSW Board.</p> |
| Amendments to Selection Criteria | <p>This Team Selection Policy may be amended or updated by Archery NSW at any time. If amended, the amended Team Selection Policy will be distributed as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Posted on the Archery NSW website • Distributed to all Archery NSW affiliated Clubs • Distributed to archers who have nominated for selection |
| Team Acceptance Agreement | <p>Archers selected on the Team are to sign a Team Acceptance Agreement to confirm their selection and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.</p> <p>Archers agree that the Archery NSW Board may remove an archer from the Team where:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • That archer has not met requirements in relation to training and participation in training camps when required. • That athlete has not completed, signed and returned to the Team Agreement and Code of Conduct, Medical and Next of Kin form and a guardian form (where applicable) as required by Archery NSW. <p>Athletes agree and acknowledge that (where applicable) selection in the Team is subject to Archery Australia receiving payment from the Athlete for participation in the National Competition as a competitor.</p> |
| Consequences of Withdrawal or Removal | Should an archer be removed from the Team for any reason the archer shall be personally responsible for any loss or damage incurred as a consequence of the removal. Archery NSW is not liable to compensate any archer for such loss or damage. |

| | Should an archer who has been selected and accepted a position on the team, later withdraw after arrangements have been made that incur costs on the part of Archery NSW, the Team Member in question will be responsible for these costs. |
| Team Uniforms | Uniforms will be supplied to the selected team members. These are to be worn at all times when at the competition/venue. Upon signing the Team Acceptance Agreement, archers shall be required to provide shirt and jacket sizes to the Youth Coordinator/Coaching Administrator. Honorary Barebow and Longbow team members will be provided a team shirt. |
| Team Support | It is anticipated that ANSW will provide the team members of the official State Representative teams, both Senior and Junior: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Official ANSW team uniform, consisting of (but not limited to) 1 Jacket & 2 Shirts • water and fruit at the venues • archer support by way of a Team Manager (and Assistant Manager where applicable) • reimbursement of entry fees for the National event at which the relevant team is competing • reimbursement of the cost of the official Presentation dinner at the relevant National event (extras like alcohol not included) • Honorary Barebow and Longbow Team will only be reimbursed for the Presentation Night dinner. |
| Any additional Matters Not Covered by this Policy | Any matters arising from the selection processes, which are not covered within this policy, shall be determined by the Archery NSW Board acting at their sole discretion. |
