

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$ 0.10 per \$ 100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 11.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$ 0.100000 per \$ 100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$ 0.094324 per \$ 100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$ 0.100678 per \$ 100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2021 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 11 from the same properties in both the 2020 tax year and the 2021 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 11 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 11 is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2021 tax year.

**A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 9, 2021 BEGINNING AT 6:00 P.M. AT THE BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 11 OFFICE LOCATED AT 4511 TEXAS PALM DRIVE, CONVERSE, TEXAS 78109.**

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Bexar County is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 11 at their office or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE TAX RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 11 last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 11 this year.
