The Legacy Guild was formed by a group of local men in 2012. They were drawn together after a cluster of sudden and unexpected deaths of treasured friends and neighbors. The organization formed within weeks of these tragic events to honor the legacy of those parents who have died in our community and offer support to their children.

In 2020, we provided over \$200,000 to 85 scholars.

*Since 2012, The Legacy Guild has provided over **ONE MILLION dollars** in college scholarship awards to 176 Scholars.*



Scholarship Information

- Each scholar currently receives \$2,500 per year, renewable for four years of undergraduate college – up to \$10,000 per eligible scholar.
- Students must live in Lyons Township District 204 and have lost a parent.
- Eligible students must live in District 204 but may attend high school elsewhere
