
4 Steps in the Grant Application Process



Steps in the Grant Review Process

Step 1: LOI Review: Confirm Eligibility

• Grant Standing Committee members review LOI eligibility to ensure organizations are eligible to apply for a grant.

Step 2: Grant readers and financial review committee members review all grant applications

• Members select which applicants move to the finalists, based on scoring and discussion.

Step 3: Grant Standing Committee members may conduct site visits for "new" applicants.

• Grants committee members meet the board and staff of the applicant to gain a deeper understanding of the organization.

Step 4: Select finalists

• The list of finalists is presented to the Seeds of Strength Board for approval. Once approved, applicants are notified and are required to present a short oral presentation to the entire membership of the voting event. Membership votes on their choice of the finalists, deciding the outcome of the final grant awards.
