

GRYC COVID-19 Policy

GRYC will follow the COVID-19 policies of the State of Ohio and the Lake County Health Department.

Anyone who is sick or showing any symptoms of COVID-19:

1. Must not enter the GRYC grounds or use any GRYC facilities
2. Must inform the board and any members who they may have had contact with in the last 14 days of their condition.

The board will communicate anyone's positive COVID-19 condition to members by e-mail.

Members shall have unlimited access to the club grounds, clubhouse, bathrooms, kitchen, and patio.

Guests and transient dockers shall have limited access to the grounds and bathrooms.

Members are responsible for informing their guests of GRYC's COVID-19 policy and seeing that they comply with that policy.

The following practices are required by everyone including members, guests, and transient dockers:

- Everyone must practice social distancing.
- Everyone must use shared/common areas as little as possible.
- Everyone must frequently wash or sanitize their hands, especially prior to and upon leaving potentially contaminated areas.
- Everyone entering an area should assume that surfaces are contaminated and clean them prior to use.
- Everyone shall clean an area that they may have contaminated prior to leaving that area.
- Everyone must wear a mask when inside of the clubhouse.
- Groups shall be limited to no more than 10 people.

Each member is responsible for determining the COVID-19 practices they will use on their own boat. The club recommends that you practice the following suggestions from ODNR:

- Limit the people aboard your boat to people in your immediate household.
- Stay at least 6 feet away from other people who do not live in your house.
- Maintain safe distance when loading up at the marina or at the fuel dock.
- Wash hands frequently or use a hand sanitizer, such as after touching a marina gate or fuel pump.
- Don't raft up to other boaters or pull up onto a beach next to someone else as it could put you in close proximity to others.
- Go right from your house to the boat and back so that you don't have unnecessary contact with anyone.

GRYC will not be held responsible for any member, guest, or transient docker who acquires a COVID-19 infection from any other member, guest, or transient docker while on club property or participating in any club activities.

Given the dynamic nature of the situation, this policy may be changed by the Board as necessary. Revisions to this policy will be distributed by e-mail and will be posted in the clubhouse.

GRYC COVID-19 Policy for the Swimming Pool

Due to Covid-19 we have additional guidelines in place to ensure the safety and health of all users. The following guidelines must be followed for any users of the pool:

- Stay home if you are sick or do not feel well.
- Using social distancing and maintain at least six feet or more between individuals in all areas of the pool and deck whenever possible.
 - Please do not sit within six feet of the pool stairs.
 - If person(s) are exiting the pool and person(s) are entering the pool at the same time, provide the person(s) exiting the right of way.
- No gathering in groups of different households.
- Swimmers should not stand, sit, or otherwise block walkways or any identified narrow passage area.
- Encourage face covering when entering buildings or interacting in close proximity to other swimmers, practice good personal hygiene including washing hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, using hand sanitizer, refraining from touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands, coughing and sneezing into an elbow, etc.
