## New Business

- Budget Revision
  - Budget changes
    - Made 8,500 with Chiefs academy
    - Made 6,000 at the bookfair
    - We need to revisit our budget each year-mid year
    - We brought Harvest Hoedown up to revenue
    - Arts and Science night was updated
    - Kind Club Change- wanted to include everyone who is helping
    - 5<sup>th</sup> grade party-increased the budget amount
    - Classroom supplies-matching what we spent
    - Walk 'n' Roll is lower than we budgeted
    - Water system change
    - Food pantry- this has been a new program
  - Playground project spending vote
    - The school has requested for outdoor improvements
    - We are asking for \$60,000 as an increase in the budget to pay for the playgrounds
      - Mrs. Verano and the school would like to expand the kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade playground
      - We are hoping to put in one to two new structures
      - We are also wanting to add a 4-square court
      - At the bottom of the hill we would like to add a climbing structure and multiple 4-square courts
      - The concrete path down to the garden as well
  - We would have 20-30k left to begin the year next year
    - Ashley Dedekind made the motion
    - Liz McGlammery second-the motion
    - The ayes have it and the motion has been approved
